





1. National Mission in Education through ICT

We have been sanctioned to develop four courses during 2011-2014 with a budget of ₹28 Lakhs.

2. Setting of Virtual Classrooms and Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs)

We have been sanctioned with ₹4.5 Crores and we are about to claim ₹3.0 crores towards the courses to be developed for the period 2022-24.

National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT)

Ministry of Education has framed a policy in the name of "National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT)" for enhancing the scientific pedagogical and leadership skills of the inductee teachers and senior faculty members of the Technical Institutions of the country. The initiative was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Education, Government of India on 12th January 2020 and the MOOCs modules have been offered to the technical teachers from January 2020. According to the policy, there are two stages of programmes such as Stage – I and Stage – II.

- Stage I consist of eight MOOCs on the pedagogy domain and it is applicable to the
 faculty members who are having less than five years of teaching experience. As per
 the policy, there are three stages in the successful completion NITTT stage I for the
 inductee faculty members in the span of three years as follows:
- Successful completion of 8 MOOC modules through the NITTT portal. The eight modules are as follows.

- One-month Industrial training concurrence with Mentor (Senior Faculty Member)
- Mentor based training under a senior faculty
- Stage II modules are identified in the policy and the modules are applicable to the faculty members who are having more than five years of teaching experience in academic institutions.

Coordination Fee for NITTT Scheme

- 1. Registration fee for NITTT Scheme Rs. 2000 / participant
- 2. Coordination fee Rs. 1000 for each module

NITTTR Chennai in collaboration with other NITTTRs has developed eight modules of Stage – I NITTT MOOCs for inductee faculty members and successfully running the same at SWAYAM Vertical – II from 2020. Presently 9th batch of running in the SWAYAM vertical –II. The senior faculty members have been trained in the mentoring process through Mentor Orientation Training Programme (MOTP) periodically by NITTTRs. Subsequently, twelve higher level MOOC modules are developed by the NITTTRs for the senior faculty members of the technical institution as per the policy guidelines. The draft policy for the implementation of higher-level modules also prepared by the committee,

Current status of implementation and activities of NITTT is as follows:

- 1. In NITTT platform, at present 26567 faculty members have registered and undergoing the stage -1 NITTT MOOCs.
- 2. In NITTT Platform, a total of 15666 participants have certified across various modules.
- Totally 9154 participants have successfully completed all eight pedagogy MOOCs modules at SWAYAM Vertical – II and started the next phase - mentoring.
- 4. NITTT Webserver and DB server running at NITTTR Chennai Data Centre. To set up the servers, Rs. 25 Lakhs allotted.
- 5. NITTTR Chennal jointly with other NITTTRs conducting Mentor training programme for the young faculty members. Totally 2249 participants are doing their mentoring by implementing the pedagogy practices in the classroom for one theory and a Laboratory course and submit the evidence to the senior faculty member of the same institution.
- 6. Domain registration of nittt.ac.in from NITTTR Chennai

- 7. Participant registration to Certification has been done in the portal
- 8. Conducting Remote Proctored Examination at the end of every semester through NTA
- 9. Conducting MOOCs at Online Degree vertical II coordination with NPTEL, IIT Chennai
- 9. Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT)
 Under PMMMNMTT, we have sanctioned with two ARPIT courses. NITTTR Chennai successfully developed and offered two courses; (1) Civil Infrastructure for Smart City Development and (2) Sustainable Construction Materials and Techniques.

Some notable measures include the establishment of four NITTTRs as exclusive teacher training hubs. Additionally, the UGC, Academic Staff College, and AICTE ATAL programs also emphasize teacher education.
- The introduction of initiatives such as PMMMNMTT (Pandit Madhan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teacher Teaching) and the launch of the NITTT (National Initiative of Technical Teachers Training) program reflect the government's commitment to improving teacher training. The SWAYAM platform, with a specific focus on NC NITTTR, further underscores the emphasis on teacher education.
- Under the PMMMNMTT, the ARPIT program has been initiated. Notably, NITTTR Chennai has extended its training to teachers from NITs, IIITs, various universities, colleges, and even medical professionals, including 100 doctors from Safdarjung Hospital (VMMC) and 120 dental doctors from Maharashtra.

Four National Institutes of Technical Teachers Training and Research (NITTTRs) were established during the year 1964 to 1967 as autonomous institutes by the Ministry of Education, Government of India to improve the quality of the technical education system in the country. In its inception, NITTTR was known as Technical Teacher Training Institute (TTTI) for each region.

With this mandate of improving technical education in the country especially polytechnic education, the Government of India started its first Technical Teachers Training Institute in Chennai in the year 1964. The main objective of the institute is listed as:

- 1. To train teachers for diploma institutions through long, modular, and short courses.
 - a) To foster and promote research:
 - b) In improving classroom and laboratory techniques
 - c) In developing an understanding of teaching.
 - d) In all aspects of curriculum development and testing.
- 2. To prepare and supply wherever necessary, teaching aids, and instructional material including filmstrips, technical films, and other aids to polytechnics.
- 3. To associate the institute with state councils and other academic bodies on technical education in the region, regarding curriculum development, admission procedures and examination reforms.
- 4. To collaborate with institutes or organisations in India and abroad that have similar objectives and functions.
- 5. To take initiative in improving polytechnic education
- 6. To act as centres for disseminating information to all agencies interested in technical education.
- 7. To collaborate with industries in the region in formulating training programmes of mutual interest

In the year 2003, the TTTI was rechristened as NITTTR with the increase in the scope of the training entire gamut of technical education (Polytechnic and Engineering). Within this mandate, NITTTR Chennai is committed to offering short- and long-term in-service training programmes through appropriate modes (online/offline) and develop curricula and instructional resources for technical education and also offers academic consultancy services for the total development of engineering colleges, polytechnics, vocational institutions, industry, service sector and the community at large.

In the past 50 years, we are serving the country in the implementation of World Bank/ADB-funded Technical Education Projects, and other projects of national importance viz., National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT), Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds (SWAYAM), National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT), Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT).

NITTTR Chennai proposed the framework to accredit and transfer the accrued credits (Bank of Credits) for the successful completion and certification of training programmes. Similarly, NITTTR Chennai is offering professional development programmes aligned with the doctrines of National Education Policy 2020. In the present digital era, NITTTR Chennai inculcates the techniques and tools to enhance the teaching skills of technical teachers. Some special courses are slated in the area of immersive technologies (Virtual Reality and Augmented Reality) and Gamification in education. By training the teachers in the emerging thrust areas, we are placing them at ease in developing the knowledge society. We also propose to offer courses of international standards, viz., Master's in Learning, Design, and Technology; Education for Sustainable Development; Cognitive Computing; Society 5.0 and Smart Infrastructure Engineering and Management respectively. Eventually, NITTTR Chennai as one of the nine National Coordinators of SWAYAM for Teacher Training, through the SWAYAM technical teachers will upgrade their knowledge.

During the year 2020, the Ministry of Education and AICTE ventured into reforming technical education by empowering the teachers through the National Initiative for Technical Teacher Training (NITTT), which covers the entire gamut of newly inducted technical teachers and NITTTR Chennai has been identified as the Coordinator (NITTT) and offers eight modules in Phase I. In Phase II, NITTTRs developed modules for the senior faculty members. At present, we are in process of

rolling out the framework to align the training credits with the National Credit Framework.

From the year 1964, NITTTR Chennai as an extended arm of the Ministry of Education empowered the faculty members of Polytechnic and Engineering College. Our clientele system is predominantly from the polytechnic education system till 2003 and after NITTTR extended its horizon to encompass both polytechnic and engineering, in addition to its international candidate. This institute has been pioneering in offering the first-ever degree course in teacher education, exclusively for polytechnic teachers holding a graduate degree in engineering subjects in the country.

The activities of NITTTR towards the polytechnic education is listed below:

- a) In 1966, the first course leading to Diploma in Technical Teaching (Dip. T. T.) was started with an intake of 60 teacher trainees.
- b) In 1967, the institute started receiving aid from U.K. under the Colombo Plan by way of equipment, secondment of staff and training and faculty abroad.
- c) In 1970, a Curriculum Development Centre was established under the Quality Improvement Programme of Government of India to launch short-term courses and curriculum development workshops.
- d) In 1970, another course leading to Diploma in Science Teaching (Dip. Sc. T.) with a complement of 20 polytechnic teachers of Science and Mathematics was introduced.
- e) In 1974, another course leading to Bachelor of Technical Education (B.Tech.
 Ed.) affiliated to the University of Madras was introduced with an intake of 20 engineering graduate teachers of Polytechnics.
- f) In 1976, an extension centre at Kalamaserry in Kerala was established to closely liaise with the polytechnics and the Directorate of Technical Education in the state.
- g) In 1977, another extension centre at Hyderabad in Andhra Pradesh was started.
- h) In 1978, the institute started getting UNDP assistance in collaboration with the other, TTTIs in the country in the areas of Educational Research, the Production of Educational films, National Testing Service and the production of multi-media learning packages.

- In 1979, the Diploma course in Science Teaching was converted into a correspondence -cum-contact programme to enable the teachers to pursue this programme at their doorstep.
- j) In 1979, the institute has been recognized as one of the associated centres of APEID, UNESCO regional office, Bangkok in the area of Technical / Vocational Education.
- k) In 1980 Another course leading to "Certificate Course in Technical Teaching (Cert.TT) was introduced for the teachers of the polytechnics in the diversified disciplines.
- I) Another extension centre at Bangalore in Karnataka was started.
- m) A computer centre procuring a mini micro-78 was commissioned and an educational media centre was started to design, develop and fabricate instructional aids for supply to the polytechnics.
- n) In early 1990 started a unique Ph.D programme in the country to emphasise the importance of engineering, affiliated with the University of Madras. The institute offered PhD in Engineering Education.
- o) From the year 2003, the institute started offering programmes to engineering and universities on the various aspects of pedagogy.
- p) In the year 2018, we started offering teacher-specific MOOCs under SWAYAM. For both polytechnic and engineering, we are offering MOOCs related to the area of pedagogy.
- q) In the year 2018, we started offering a unique master's programme in Civil Engineering titled "Infrastructure Engineering and Management. The number of the masters programme is expanded to five and it scaffolds the teaching needs of the country.

(d) The Significant Achievements of NITTTR Chennai

- For the past 50 years, the Institute has enriched around 1,50,000 technical teachers from Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala and other States through need oriented customized short term training programmes.
- 2) More than 95 research scholars were awarded Ph.D. in Engineering Education by the University of Madras from 2000 onwards.

- 3) The institute has played a vital role in developing/revising curricula for diploma programmes of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Kerala state. And also, the faculty members of the institute rendered expertise for curricula development to the technical institutes in our country.
- 4) The institute has developed/updated a number of course materials/lab manuals in various engineering subjects, and pedagogy for use by teachers of technical institutions.
- 5) The institute has specially designed and offering number of training programmes aligned with NEP 2020.
- 6) The NITTTR Chennai serving as a national coordinator for teachers Education, through the SWAYAM around 370000 participants attended/attending from all corners of the world.
- 7) the AICTE has framed a policy in the name of "National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT)". NITTTR Chennai has been identified as the Coordinating agency for this policy. There are totally eight modules have been developed as stage-I. A total of around 100000 technical teachers are enrolled in these eight modules.
