1. LIBRARY & INFORMATION SCIENCE

Library and Society: Laws of library science, various types of libraries, library associations, systems, and initiatives, as well as Indian library legislation; organisations and institutions - UNESCO, IFLA, FID, INIS, NISSAT, etc. involved in the growth of library and information services;

2. LIBRARY MANAGEMENT:

Collection development – Acquisition Process, Journal and Periodical Acquisition, Document Preparation for Use, Library Staff and Committee, and Library Rules and Regulations; Money and budget for libraries; principles of library management, structure, and organisation; Traffic, upkeep, shelving, inventory verification, binding and preservation, weeding out, etc. are all aspects of using and maintaining the library;

3. LIBRARY CLASSIFICATION THEORY AND PRACTICE:

Canons and Principles, Library Classification Schemes– DDC, CC, UDC.

4. LIBRARY CATALOGUING THEORY AND PRACTICE:

Canons and Principles; Library Cataloguing Codes – CCC and AACR.

5. REFERENCE AND INFORMATION SOURCES:

Bibliography and Reference Sources – Types of Bibliography; Reference Sources – Dictionaries, Encyclopedias, Ready Reference Sources, etc.; Sources of Information – Primary, Secondary, Tertiary, Documentary, Non-Documentary; E-Documents, E-Books, E-Journals, etc., Intellectual Property Rights(IPR), Copyright Act, Open Educational Resources.

6. INFORMATION SERVICES:

Concept and need for Information; Types of Documents; Nature and organization of Information Services, Abstracting and Indexing Services; Computer based Information Services – CAS, SDI; Information Technology: Basics Introduction to computers; Use of computers in Library housekeeping, Library Automation; Software and software packages; Networks – Consortium – INFLIBNET, DELNET, NICNET, etc.; National and International Information Systems – NISSAT, NASSDOC, INSDOC, DESIDOC, etc.
