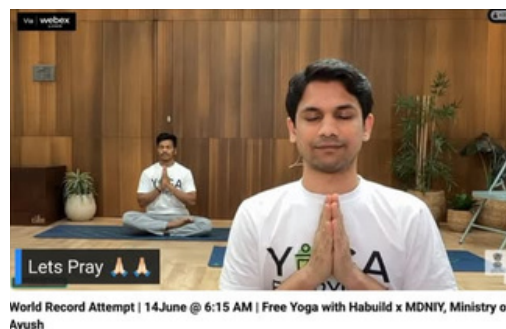
Highlights of the Day:
