Driving (Two wheeler, LMV, EV-Auto available at the Institute.)</li> <li>2. Electrician (Electrical Helper)</li> <li>3. Plumber (Plumbing Helper)</li> <li>4. A/C Mechanic (A/C Mechanic Helper)</li> <li>5. Gardener</li> <li>6. Sweeping and Mopping</li> <li>7. Cleaning (including Garden, vessels, tank, water sump, toilets, etc.)</li> <li>8. Carpentry</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Instructions to Candidates:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each candidate may choose <b>any three (3) skill categories</b> from the above list based on their own choice while applying.</li> <li>• The skill test will be conducted only in the categories selected by the candidate.</li> <li>• Each skill test carries a maximum of 10 marks. To qualify, candidates must score a minimum of 5 marks in each skill test. Scoring less than 5 marks in any skill test will result in disqualification from progressing to the next stage of the recruitment process.</li> <li>• However, upon selection, the candidate will be required to perform all the tasks mentioned above for the skill test, as well as any other duties related to the responsibilities of Multi-Tasking Staff, whenever assigned by any higher authority.</li> </ul>
